**Subject:** Reroute of In-transit Munitions due to Construction at Joint Base McGuire-Dix-Lakehurst (JB MDL), NJ (WRI)

**Purpose:** To notify all defense transportation system customers of the construction delay at JB MDL's in-transit munitions facility and subsequent requirement to continue re-routing munitions shipments to Dover AFB, DE (DOV).

**Be Advised:** Due to construction delays, at the JB MDL in-transit munitions facility, shippers should continue re-routing all export/outbound munitions that would normally transit JB MDL according to the airlift channel sequence listing/movement plan to Dover AFB, DE. The new projected construction completion date is 1 March 2013.

As a reminder, all non-FMS munitions destined for or transiting thru Qatar via military airlift must be pre-cleared thru Qatari customs prior to being accepted at the Aerial Port of Embarkation (APOE). Customs pre-clearance is a shipper's responsibility and must be accomplished utilizing the GHQ (General Headquarters of Qatar) letter. The GHQ letter must accompany the shipment when delivered to the APOE. The APOE will not accept munitions shipments destined for or transiting thru Qatar without the GHQ letter.

Base terminating munitions shipments consigned to the Army Ammunition Supply Point (W15A9U) or JB MDL Munitions Storage Area (FB4484) and (FE4484) will still be accepted and should not be routed to Dover AFB, DE.
