Subject: GeoFence during Super Bowl

Purpose: To advise DoD shipping activities and commercial carriers that the Defense Transportation Tracking System (DTTS) office will establish a GeoFence for the area surrounding the Superdome in New Orleans, LA during the Super Bowl.

Be Advised: DTTS will establish a GeoFence to monitor DTTS-tracked shipments moving in/out of the affected area from 0600 to 2400 central time, February 3, 2013. The GeoFence will extend approximately 50 miles from the Superdome. It includes parts of I-10, I-12, and I-55, and various DoD and US Coast Guard activities.

Guidance: Commercial carriers should use alternate routes to avoid the affected area. Recommend DOD installations plan AA&E pick-ups or deliveries appropriately.

Transportation Officers are advised to notify DTTS/SDDC for inbound/outbound motor AA&E shipments to/from the affected area. Carriers with DTTS-tracked shipments needing to penetrate the GeoFenced zone due to operational necessity must be reported to the DTTS Duty Officer at (800) 826-0794.

This advisory has been coordinated with the DTTS Joint Service Working Group.
