

Shipment Management

Shipment Management includes several processes involved with coordinating personal property moves from initial packing at origin to final unpacking at destination.

The outbound process involves arranging and scheduling the various types of Personal Property shipments (i.e. Household Goods, Unaccompanied baggage, Mobile Homes, Domestic and International Boats) with Transportation Service Providers (TSP) for Military Service Members and DoD civilians. The outbound process may include Storage-in-Transit (SIT). Normally, shipments are outbound from the Member's current duty location to their next duty assignment or retirement/separation location.

The inbound process involves shipment arrival at destination, placement into temporary storage and delivery of personal property shipments with Transportation Service Providers for Military Service Members and DoD civilians. Inbound shipments are those that are en route to, or have reached, their final destination.
