Subject: Importer Security Filing (ISF) "10+2" Full Name & Date of Birth (DoB) Requirement for Personal Property Household Goods (HHG) Shipments (Transaction Type 03).

1. Purpose: Provide an update to Transportation Service Providers (TSP) and Department of Defense (DoD) shipping activities regarding full name/DoB information requirements for ISF "10+2" filings.

2. Reference: Federal Register, Vol 73, No 228, 25 Nov 2008 (DOCID FR25NO08-22) and U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) ISF "10+2" FAQs published July 9th 2010

3. Be advised the ISF "10+2" is a Department of Homeland Security initiative to prevent importation of terrorist weapons into United States of America.

a. ISF "10+2" applies to shipments entering the United States aboard commercial sea vessels.

b. In accordance with the 9 July 2010 FAQs published by CBP, full name and DOB must be included on all HHG ISF filings. CBP has agreed to temporarily suspend ISF "rejection" messages for DoD HHG shipments to allow time for necessary modifications to the Defense Personal Property System (DPS).

c. USTRANSCOM is processing required changes to DPS to comply with CBP requirements by enabling full name/DoB information to be collected and printed on the DD Form 1252/1252-1. \*Estimated completion date is July 2011.
