**Subject:** Clearance Requirement for Outsize Cargo thru Aerial Port of Embarkation (APOE) Travis AFB

**Purpose:** To notify shippers of limitations at the 60th APS, Travis AFB, during renovations of our Mechanized Material Handling System (MMHS) and outsized cargo building/storage area.

**Be Advised:** From 1 Jun 24 to 30 Apr 25, storage and building space in the MMHS and outsize cargo area will be limited due to ongoing construction work at the terminal. 60th APS Cape Forecasting office requires that cargo exceeding the following dimensions be cleared by the Aerial Port before shipment:

Length: 108"

Width: 88"

Height: 96"

Cubic Feet: 528"

60th APS will not have an installed crane in the cargo yard during the renovations, and coordination must be conducted 10 working days prior to shipment for clearance and mobile crane allocation. Storage for outsized items is also very limited, so please contact Cape Forecasting before any outsized cargo is shipped.

The 60th APS Transportation Facilities Guide (TFG) has been updated with information contained in the advisory.
