Subject: Defense Transportation Tracking System (DTTS) GeoFencing of the Presidential Inauguration Ceremony Washington D.C., 20 January 2025

Purpose: To advise Department of Defense (DoD) shipping activities and Transportation Service Providers (TSP) that the DTTS office will establish a GeoFence for the area surrounding Washington D.C during the Presidential Inauguration.

Be Advised: DTTS will establish a GeoFence to monitor DTTS-tracked shipments moving in/out of the affected area from 0600 to 2000 Eastern Standard Time (EST), 20 January 2025. The GeoFence will extend approximately 35 miles from the Capital Building in Washington D.C. It includes parts of I-95, I-270, I-295, I-395, I-495 and various other highways leading to DoD and U.S. Coast Guard activities.

Guidance: TSPs should use alternate routes to avoid the affected area. Recommend DoD installations plan Satellite Motor Surveillance Service (SNS) pick-ups or deliveries appropriately.

Transportation Officers are advised to coordinate with SDDC/DTTS for inbound/outbound SNS shipments to/from the affected area. Shipments required to penetrate the GeoFenced zone due to operational necessity must be reported to the DTTS Operations Center at (800) 826-0794.
