TSPs **MUST** call **608-388-6002** to make appointments no earlier than Thursday, August 4, 2022, for deliveries into Fort McCoy, WI, and no later than Sunday, August 21, 2022, for shipments being picked up from Fort McCoy, WI. At time of appointment scheduling, driver name/tractor number/trailer number will be required.

All shipments must be delivered & picked up from TTB Independence. Drivers will follow directions on digital sign boards posted on HWY 21 for X Road to TTB Independence. DO NOT USE Main Gate or Gate 20.
