Subject: Mandatory Use of Carrier Appointment System (CAS) for 78th Training Division's CSTX 78-21-04

Purpose: To advise Transportation Service Providers (TSP) on use of CAS forshipments supporting CSTX 78-21-04 at Fort McCoy, Wisconsin (W5CQRF) 07 – 21 August 2021.

Be Advised: TSPs are advised that when scheduling loading/offloading appointments during the CSTX 78-21-04 at Fort McCoy, WI the below information will be required for input into CAS. This information will be provided by local Transportation Officer (TO) on their Bills of Lading (BLs):

Origin; TSP; BL number; offer number (DFTS sites only); tractor number; trailer number (If available); appointment time; container or rolling stock; sensitive item number; Hazmat information; name of the unit; bumper number for equipment/serial number for containers; unit Point of Contact (POC) to receive equipment and cell phone number.

CAS appointments are set to automatic. TSPs can make appointments no earlier than Monday, 26 July 2021 for deliveries into Fort McCoy, WI beginning on 04 August 2021 through 06 August 2021 and no earlier than Monday, 02 August 2021 for shipments being picked up from Fort McCoy, WI beginning on 15 August 2021 through 21 August 2021. At time of appointment scheduling, driver name/tractor number/trailer number will be required.

All shipments must be delivered & picked up from TTB Independence. Drivers will follow directions on digital sign boards posted on HWY 21 for X Road to TTB Independence. DO NOT USE Main Gate or Gate 20.

TSPs will be allowed access to Fort McCoy, WI 30 minutes prior to time and date of appointment to facilitate loading/offloading.
