Subject: Temporary APOE for Hazard Class 1.1 and 1.2 Munitions Currently Transported via AMC airlift thru APOE NS Norfolk.

Purpose: To notify shippers of taxiway construction at NS Norfolk which impacts airlift of 1.1/1.2 munitions.

Be Advised: APOE Naval Station Norfolk (NGU) "Foxtrot" taxiway will be closed for repairs 21 Jan – 21 Apr 25, affecting access to its "Red Label" Hot Spot via taxiway "Whiskey." During this period, NS Norfolk will not be able to accept Hazard Class 1.1 & 1.2 munitions for transport via AMC airlift.

1. AMC channel airlift:

- a. Temporary APOE will be 305 APS, Joint Base McGuire-Dix-Lakehurst. Last day NS Norfolk will accept Hazard Class 1.1 & 1.2 munitions is 10 Jan 25. POC for coordinating movement of munitions thru NS Norfolk is listed at bottom of advisory.
- b. The first day Joint Base McGuire-Dix-Lakehurst will accept Hazard Class 1.1 & 1.2 munitions is 11 Jan 25. POC for coordinating movement of munitions thru JB Joint Base McGuire-Dix-Lakehurst is listed at bottom of advisory.
- c. **Note:** This advisory does not impact other hazard classes/cargo commodities currently shipped thru APOE NS Norfolk.
- 2. SAAM/Contingency missions: When requesting SAAMs and contingencies transporting hazard class 1.1/1.2 munitions, last day a mission can be scheduled for departure is 20 Jan 25. After that date, an alternate APOE must be utilized.
