Subject: Military Freight Traffic Unified Rules Publication (MFTURP-1) 2nd Draft is Available for Review and Comment

Purpose: Inform Department of Defense (DoD) stakeholders and Transportation Service Providers (TSPs) that a revised and reformatted MFTURP-1, 2nd Draft is now available for review and comment.

Update: During the comment period, SDDC migrated all employees and orgboxes from DISA Enterprise Email (DEE) (@mail.mil) to the new Army365 (A365) email home (@army.mil). This changeover may have inadvertently led to some responses not being received. **Therefore, comment period will be extended to 24 NOV 2021. Stakeholders and TSPs are highly encouraged to resend their comments on the 2nd Draft. To date, SDDC has only received comments from four stakeholders/TSPs.**

Please note, the email address for the G3 MFTURP-1 Team has been updated below to reflect the recent migration. Stakeholders/TSPs should use the updated address when submitting comments.

Rationale: This review allows DoD stakeholders and TSPs to review changes and provide final comments and additional updates to the MFTURP-1 in its entirety. DoD Shippers and TSPs have 30 days to provide comments.

Be Advised: The second draft of the MFTURP-1 and associated documents are located on the Domestic Movement Support page of the SDDC website at <https://www.sddc.army.mil/dms/Pages/default.aspx>. Stakeholders should click on the "Regs & Docs" tab to view the proposed language, summary of changes document, adjudication document and Comment Matrix.

DoD stakeholders and TSPs should review the documents and submit comments to the MFTURP-1 Team at usarmy.scott.sddc.mbx.g3-domestic-mfturp@army.mil

NOTE: Comments must be submitted using the Comment Matrix document posted to the website.

New comments and feedback should include concurrence/non-concurrence with proposed language. If recommending a change, the exact verbiage, as well as paragraph number, line number, page number and POC information, must be included. Failure to provide this information may impact the final publication date. Provide comments via the attached Comment Matrix. Comments submitted in any other format will not be accepted. If any carriers do not intend to leave any additional comments or feedback, please let us know this as well.

Comment period runs from 12 October – 10 November. All comments and input must be received via email usarmy.scott.sddc.mbx.g3-domestic-mfturp@army.mil

Expected publication date for the updated MFTURP-1 is November 2021. This date allows sufficient time to review and adjudicate provided comments and concerns.
