Subject: Release of Updated Military Freight Traffic Unified Rules Publication (MFTURP-1)

Purpose: Inform Department of Defense (DoD) stakeholders and Transportation Service Providers (TSPs) that an updated MFTURP-1 has been published, replacing the 12 September 2022 version.

Be Advised: The MFTURP-1 establishes policy, prescribes rules and describes responsibilities for Freight Carrier Registration Program (FCRP) approved TSPs. These rules assist TSPs in providing safe, reliable and "Best Value" service to the DoD.

This update encompasses numerous changes to include:

1. Addition of SAM.gov language detailing requirements TSPs need completed to be qualified and actively registered in the FCRP.
2. Crafted cyber security requirements for FCRP-approved TSPs including instructions for reporting cyber incidents to both SDDC and USTRANSCOM.
3. Addition of Bankruptcy Policy language specifying how TSPs provide notification to SDDC and USTRANSCOM when entering into bankruptcy proceedings.
4. Complete rewrite of Section F – Air Transportation Service Provider Rules.
5. Updated correct commodity code to be used for crated HHG or personal effects shipments.
