Subject: Removal of Joint Battlefield Command-Platform (JBC-P) for Transport

Purpose: To inform Department of Defense shippers that the Mission Command Project Manager has issued official clarification to FORSCOM on when it is appropriate to remove JBC-P from military vehicles in a memorandum with the subject: Storage and Transportation of Joint Battle Command-Platform (JBC-P) Systems, dated 1 March 2024.

Be Advised: Repeated removal and reinstallation of vehicle mounted JBC-P systems by untrained personnel greatly degrades readiness for JBC-P Systems. System components and the vehicle installation kits are often removed for storage and transportation despite security and safeguarding policies which allow them to remain installed in the vehicle.
