Subject: Defense Transportation Tracking System (DTTS) GeoFencing of Super Bowl LVIII at Allegiant Stadium in Paradise, NV, 11 February 2024

Purpose: To advise Department of Defense (DoD) shipping activities and Transportation Service Providers (TSP) that the DTTS office will establish a GeoFence for the area surrounding Allegiant Stadium in Paradise, NV during Super Bowl LVIII.

Be Advised: DTTS will establish a GeoFence to monitor DTTS-monitored shipments moving in/out of the affected area from 06:30 to 23:30 Pacific Standard Time (PST), 11 February 2023. The GeoFence will extend approximately 50 miles from the Allegiant Stadium in Paradise, NV. It includes parts of I-15, I-11, and various other highways leading to DoD activities.

Guidance: TSPs should use alternate routes to avoid the affected area. Recommend DoD installations plan Satellite Motor Surveillance Service (SNS) pick-ups or deliveries appropriately.

Transportation Officers are advised to coordinate with SDDC/DTTS for inbound/outbound SNS shipments to/from the affected area. Shipments required to enter the GeoFenced zone due to operational necessity must be reported to the DTTS Operations Center at (800) 826-0794.
