## Military Surface Deployment and Distribution Command Customer and Carrier Advisory April 9, 2025 CA-25-04-09/0018 Update 1

**Subject:** Use of the Defense Transportation Tracking System (DTTS) services for Shipments of Arms, Ammunition and Explosives (AA&E) and Other Sensitive Materials (OSM)

**Purpose:** To inform Transportation Protective Service motor carriers (TPS) of when to share data with DTTS for shipment monitoring. Update 1 to update email address.

**Be Advised:** The Defense Transportation Tracking System Program Management Office will only execute the Satellite Motor Surveillance (SNS) and Trailer Tracking (DCS) transportation protective services when the motor carrier has been selected through the Domestic Tender Program via a designated Department of Defense (DOD) shipper system by a DOD Transportation Office that has been authorized by the respective Military Service Headquarters to issue CBLs and is assigned a Bill of Lading Office Code. Requests for SNS, DCS, PSS, or DDP must be documented on a DOD issued Commercial Bill of Lading generated by a DOD shipper system for the DTTS PMO to execute SNS and DCS.

**Guidance:** SDDC requests all TPS Motor Carriers transporting AA&E and OSM to not activate data sharing with DTTS PMO for SNS and DCS unless the request is documented on a DOD Issued Commercial Bill of Lading. If the shipment is not documented on a DOD Issued Commercial Bill of Lading, the TSP shall execute all requested transportation protective services but will not enable DTTS sharing with the DTTS PMO for the execution of SNS and DCS.
