

**INTERNATIONAL RATE SOLICITATION I-13
SUPPLEMENT 1 (EFFECTIVE 1 JAN 03 THRU 30 SEP 03)**

TERMINAL HANDLING CHARGE

A surcharge is authorized for Terminal Handling Charges between the Pacific Coast Ports and Hawaii ports. Effective 1 Jan 03 through 30 Sep 03, these charges will be paid when shown on the Ocean Bill of Lading (OBL) between the effective dates. Effective IW03, these charges must be included in carrier's rate submissions.

Terminal Handling Charges for shipments moving between the Pacific Coast and Hawaii will be payable as a surcharge as described below:

Shipments moving from the Pacific Coast to Hawaii a charge of \$200 per ocean container will apply as shown on the OBL. Less than container shipments will have to be prorated and shown on the OBL.

Shipments moving from Hawaii to the Pacific Coast a charge of \$100 per container will apply. Less than container shipments will have to be prorated and shown on the OBL.

Billings to DFAS: These additional charges will have to be shown separately on any invoices. When submitting billing by EDI, carriers must use EDI code COF, (ocean freight surcharge). Carriers must also include in the L112 (special charge description) field of the EDI invoice: **"Terminal Handling Charge"**. Carriers must maintain back up documentation when submitting billing by EDI.
