**Subject:** Release of Updated Military Freight Traffic Unified Rules Publication (MFTURP-1)

**Purpose:** Inform Department of Defense (DoD) stakeholders and Transportation Service Providers (TSPs) that an updated MFTURP-1 has been published, replacing the 23 March 2022 version.

**Be Advised:** The MFTURP-1 establishes policy, prescribes rules and describes responsibilities for Freight Carrier Registration Program approved TSPs. These rules assist TSPs in providing safe, reliable and "Best Value" service to the DoD.

This update encompasses four changes:

- 1. Addition of clarifying note to the Transportation Facilities Guide (TFG) Section A., Part III. Paragraph E.2. (administrative)
- 2. Updated Regional State Code/Province Code for Quebec, Canada in Section A., Part IV., C., Tender Rate Sections D, E and G Through I (administrative)
- 3. The addition of Deficit Weight Rating logic to Section A, Part IV. C., Tender Rate Sections D, E, and G Through I, Paragraph 1
- 4. Return to previous language (2020 version) Item 23 Detention: Vehicles without Power Units, Paragraph 6 (administrative)
