Brigadier General Steven T. Eveker is the Commanding General, Deployment Support Command in Birmingham, Alabama and the Deputy Commander for Mobilization for the Military Surface Deployment and Distribution Command at Scott Air Force Base, Illinois.

General Eveker was born in Saint Louis, Missouri and was commissioned as a Second Lieutenant in the United States Army Infantry in May 1986. He holds a Bachelor of Arts degree in Government from Campbell University and a Master of Science degree in Strategic Studies from the U.S. Army War College. His military education includes: Infantry Officer Basic Course, Quartermaster Officer Advanced Course, Joint Fire Control Course, Combined Arms and Staff Services School, Command and General Staff College, Defense Strategy Course, Reserve Component National Security Course, Defense Support of Civil Authorities Course and the U.S. Army War College. He is a graduate of the United States Army Airborne, Air Assault, Ranger and Jumpmaster Schools.



General Eveker assumed command of the Deployment Support Command on 21 September 2014. Prior to this assignment, he was deployed in support of Operation Enduring Freedom with ARCENT/3rd Army serving as the Chief of Staff for the ARCENT Support Element-Afghanistan (ASE-A) in Kabul, Afghanistan.

He has served as Brigade Commander for the 209th Regional Support Group in Kansas City, Missouri; Deputy Exercise Director for the 2nd Brigade, 75th Division at Fort Dix, New Jersey; Deputy Commanding Officer for the 642nd Regional Support Group in Decatur, Georgia; and Assistant G-3 for the 84th Division (IT) in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. He also served with the 108th Division (IT) as the Brigade S-3, Battalion S-3, Assistant Brigade S-3, Battalion S-4, Aide de Camp to the Commanding General and IET Company Commander. He also served with the 1st Battalion, 509th Infantry (Airborne) OPFOR at the Joint Readiness Training Center (JRTC) at Fort Chaffee/Little Rock AFB, Arkansas, as a Rifle Platoon Leader, Battalion S-3 Air, and Support Platoon Leader.

In 1990, he was promoted to the rank of captain and was branch transferred to the Quartermaster Corps and served with the Division Support Command (DISCOM) of the 24th Infantry Division (Mechanized) during Operations Desert Shield and Desert Storm. In 2006, he was selected to serve as the Battalion Commander of the 352nd Corps Support Battalion (CSB) and deployed the unit to Mosul, Iraq, in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom.

His awards and decorations include: Legion of Merit Medal; Bronze Star Medal with one oak leaf cluster; Meritorious Service Medal; Army Commendation Medal with silver oak leaf cluster; Army Achievement Medal with 2 oak leaf clusters; Combat Action Badge; Expert Infantryman's Badge; Ranger Tab; Senior Parachutist Badge; and Air Assault Badge.

In his civilian career, General Eveker is the President and CEO of Eveker Diversified Industrial Services.
