



## **Colonel Joseph R. Morrow**

Deputy Commanding Officer

Colonel Joseph Morrow is the Deputy Commanding Officer for Military Surface Deployment and Distribution Command (SDDC). He is a native of Whitewater, Wisconsin. He graduated and received his commission from University of Dubuque in 1992. He previously served as G4 – Sustainment Chief for Eighth Army in the Republic of Korea.

A career logistics officer, COL Morrow has served in command and leadership positions from platoon leader to Brigade Commander. He served as the 59th Commander of the Watervliet Arsenal, NY and Deputy J4 from June 2014 – July 2016 at U.S. European Command. From June 2012 to June 2013, he served as the Assistant Chief of Staff – G4 (Sustainment Chief) for the 25th Infantry Division. COL Morrow served as the Commander of 325th Brigade Support Battalion in support of 3rd Brigade, 25th Infantry Division from January 2010 to Jun 2012. COL Morrow served three tours with the 101st Airborne Division from 1999 to 2009, two tours with 526th Forward Support Battalion and Brigade Support Battalion supporting 2nd Brigade and one tour as Deputy G4. Prior to serving in the 101st Airborne, he served two years at the University of California – Santa Barbara, ROTC as the Assistant Professor of Military Science. Upon completion of the Ordnance Basic Course, COL Morrow was assigned to the 596th Maintenance Company at Darmstadt, Germany as a Platoon Leader and Shop Officer. In 1995, he was assigned to the 485th Corps Support Battalion at Hanau, Germany as the Assistant S-3 Operation Officer.



Colonel Morrow’s operational deployments include Operation Joint Endeavor in Bosnia-Herzegovina; three tours supporting Operation Iraqi Freedom; and one tour supporting Operation Enduring Freedom in Afghanistan.

Colonel Morrow’s military education includes Ordnance Officer Basic and the Combined Logistics Officers Advanced Courses and General Staff College, and United States Air War College. He holds a Bachelor’s Degree in Aviation Management from University of Dubuque, Master’s Degrees from Webster University (Human Resource Management) and from the Air War College (National Security and Strategic Studies). He is also a graduate of the Depot and Arsenal Executive Leadership Program at University of North Carolina.

His awards and decorations include the Defense Superior Service Medal, Legion of Merit with 2 oak leaf clusters, Bronze Star Medal with three oak leaf clusters, Meritorious Service Medal with four oak leaf clusters, Army Commendation Medal with two oak leaf clusters, Army Achievement Medal, Combat Action Badge and Air Assault Badge.
