SUBJECT: Change of Designation of Exigency Areas for USC-7

1. In accordance with USC-7, Paragraph 6.A, I hereby cancel the designation of Libya, Senegal, Liberia, Ghana, Sierra Leone, Gambia, Guinea-Bissau, and Cote d'Ivoire as Exigency Areas effective immediately.
2. The following countries remain designated as Exigency Areas: Afghanistan, Iraq, and Pakistan.
3. This designation and all contractual clauses governing Exigency Areas will remain in effect for these countries until the designation is rescinded.
4. Based on the current operational environment and the data available to us, it is likely that a substantial number of commercial containers transiting or consigned to locations in these countries will not be returned to the carriers due to U.S. Government necessity.
5. Additional countries or areas meeting the Exigency Area criteria will be designated as such via separate memorandum when necessary.
