

Direct Procurement Method

The Direct Procurement Method (DPM) Program was established to manage the shipment of domestic household goods, international-household goods, and unaccompanied baggage shipments using Federal Acquisition Regulations (FAR)-based government contracts. Upon request of personal property shipping offices (PPSOs), DPM contracts are solicited and awarded through a local Contracting Office. DPM contracts are administered by local PPSOs and include packing, containerization, local drayage, delivery, unpacking, storage and related services for personal property shipments. DPM contracts provide PPSOs a comprehensive movement process for worldwide movement of small shipments and larger shipments to specific overseas locations where other modes of shipment are not authorized.
