Subject: Movement of DoD Cargo into Site D, Turkey (FY3052) in Support of Operation INHERENT RESOLVE (OIR)

Purpose: To provide MICAP and other high transportation priority (TP) shipment instructions for all DoD shippers.

Be Advised: For all mission capable (MICAP)/999 and other high TP shipments in support of OIR, Total Delivery Service (TDS) carriers are now allowed to transport shipments into Site D under the NATO Form 302. See MSDDC Advisory CA-15-10/23-0123-Update 1 for import shipment requirements to Turkey in support of OIR.

NOTE #1: All shipments consigned for Site D will use the following address:

NOTE #2: When consigning cargo to Site D in support of OIR, it is pertinent all shipment/transportation documents and Form 302 reflect the following statement, "US Forces Cargo in Support of Operation INHERENT RESOLVE." As well, make sure to specify the exact nomenclature for the cargo, not a generic nomenclature (i.e, aircraft part), along with the National Stock Number (NSN), otherwise your cargo may get delayed by customs.
