Subject: Update 1- Draft Update to Military Freight Traffic Unified Rules Publication-1 (MFTURP-1)

Purpose: To advise Carriers that the suspense date for review of the updated MFTURP is extended to 13 May vs 13 April 2016.

Be Advised: That updates to the MFTURP have been posted to the SDDC Docketing System for review and comment. This publication establishes policy, prescribes rules, and describes responsibilities for motor, rail, water, pipeline, air, and tank-truck Transportation Service Providers (TSP). This revision is being released to update outdated information and to clear up some outdated language. The version located on the Docketing System has Summary of Changes highlighted which depicts updates. Additional updates are also highlighted throughout the publication.

Please review at your earliest convenience and provide changes/any additional recommendations not later than **13 May 2016**, via the Docketing System. This publication is available digitally on the SDDC public website (upper right LINKS, Docketing System):

SDDC will review and adjudicate all comments received from Industry. If needed, language can (or may) be rewritten to address the findings of the review. If re-written, the revised language must be staffed through SDDC again before moving forward. Upon final review/change, publication will go to the SDDC Staff Judge Advocate for legal review.

Any change that results in a significant effect, significant cost or administrative impact will be published in the Federal Register in accordance with 41, U.S.C. §418. The effective date of the change will be published on the SDDC website and if a significant change, it will be published in the Federal Register. On the effective date, all changes will become effective and bind the Transportation Service Providers (TSP).
