SUBJECT: Defense Personal Property System (DPS) International Code of Service 5 Channel Deletion(s) Azores (P001) to/from Hawaii (US89) COS 5 Channels

1. In accordance with the International Tender and based on the Military Sealift Command mission, COS 5 service options from California (US87 & US88) to/from Hawaii (US89) is being removed from the remaining 2013 DPS rate cycle and future DPS rate cycles until further notice. The following channels are effected:

2. All active bids for 2013 rate cycle on these two COS 5 channels have been withdrawn from DPS effective 31 January 2014. PPSO's are advised to not award and/or TSPs should not receive any future COS 5 shipments on these two Intl channels. In addition, these two COS 5 channels will not be available for bidding during the 2014 Rate Filing and ask that all approved TSPs bid accordingly.

3. In the event TSP(s) file rates during 2014 round 1 or 2 on these two COS 5 channels and depending on the method of rate filing, DPS will issue either an overnight exception Bulk Rate Validation Error Code or Errors at the time rate filer attempts to validate bids while using Bidlinx. Be advised, RFQ Workbench rate filing method will not populate the above two COS 5 channels.
