SUBJ: DP3 Webinar Training on \*New\* Mold Language

1. New for 2014! This Webinar event addresses TSP and PPSO actions when mold is suspected or confirmed within a personal property shipment. Participants will learn about the reporting process, customer notification, PPSO and TSP quality assurance actions, cleaning versus salvage or disposal, and remediation for contaminated articles.
