SUBJ: Storage In Transit (SIT) For 2014 Peak Season

1. This message is a reminder to utilize storage options that will best assist the customer, PPSOs, and TSPs.

2. For hard to service areas, such as Northern Tier areas (i.e., Region 4--North Dakota, South Dakota, Wyoming, and Montana), TSPs are encouraged to use best commercial practices when selecting SIT facilities.

Note: TSPs may use any DoD-approved SIT facility to assist where storage capacity issues arise.

3. TSPs utilizing origin SIT must invoice for delivery into origin SIT, and the delivery out will be the linehaul to destination. TSPs are not authorized to invoice for linehaul while a shipment is in origin SIT.

4. For TSPs utilizing destination SIT, the delivery out is based on the Government Bill of Lading (GBL) Block 18 to the actual delivery address. TSPs are paid based on the linehaul charge from Block 19 to Block 18.

5. If a TSP stores a shipment(s) in the origin area and selects "destination SIT", the TSP shall not invoice for the linehaul until the shipment has been delivered.
