SUBJ: Defense Personal Property System (DPS) Implementation of Canada Shipments under the International One-Time-Only Program

1. Effective 01 April 2015, the Department of Defense will transition CONUS to/from Canada Code 1 & 2 Special Solicitation (SS) shipment channels from Electronic Transportation Operations Personal Property System (ETOPS) to DPS One-Time-Only (OTO) Code of Service (COS) 4 shipments.

a. CONUS to/from Canada shipments prior to 01 April 2015 will continue to be processed in ETOPS using Special Solicitation rates on file.

b. Current CONUS to/from Canada SS shipments routed and awarded in ETOPS will not be impacted.

c. This transition is in accordance with our 18 Dec 14 message that states TSPs understand that the use of DPS will increase as system capability progresses.

2. JPPSO-North Central (NC) in Colorado Springs (KKFA) will assume responsibility for all inbound and outbound iHHG COS 4 and iUB COS 8 shipments in DPS to/from Canada. Note: Please refer to the DPS Personal Property Consignment Instruction Guide for JPPSO-NC POCs.

3. This change will only apply to DOD shipments where the member is NOT assigned to Chief of Mission (Embassy).
