SUBJECT: Defense Personal Property System (DPS) Shipment Management Outbound Route and Award Offer Management

1. In preparation for the upcoming 2015 Peak Season, SDDC is monitoring daily the Shipment Management queues for shipments picking up 15 May 2015 and later, specifically the Route and Award queues. SDDC has noticed PPSOs are processing shipments differently and encourages PPSOs follow this guidance to both help manage workload and improve reporting on shipments that are in the queue.
2. Recent shipment data analysis shows that as of 20 March 2015 there are 5,565 shipments awaiting creation of traffic distribution lists for 15 May 2015 and beyond. Of those, more than half (3,095) are in the second to last step (status of 'Reviewed by Counselor and Approved to go to Route/Book') while 2,470 are in the final step (status of 'Transportation Service Provider (TSP) Selection') awaiting the new Traffic Distribution List (TDL).
3. It is very important for the PPSOs/JPPSOs to process the shipments up to the final step and assign a Code of Service, when possible. This will save time once the TDL is built and also allow for more accurate reports from SDDC to industry to help them adjust in anticipation of these shipments being awarded.
4. As of 19 March, the following sites have the largest number of shipments that are in a "Reviewed by Counselor and Approved to go to Route/Book" and, where possible, should have a Code of Service assigned so that they will be in a "Transportation Service Provider (TSP) Selection" status.
