SUBJECT: Defense Personal Property Program (DP3) Peak Season Shipment Data & Blackouts

1. In preparation for the upcoming 2015 Peak Season, SDDC is monitoring daily the Shipment Management queues for shipments picking up 15 May 2015 and later, specifically the Route and Award queues.
2. Data analysis as of 20 March 2015 shows there are 5,552 shipments awaiting creation of traffic distribution lists for 15 May 2015 and beyond. Of those, 2,444 are in the final step (status of 'Transportation Service Provider (TSP) Selection') awaiting the new Traffic Distribution List (TDL).
3. The attached report provides industry with details on the origin, destination, requested pickup date, and estimated weight of all 5,552 shipments (Code of service only available if in the final step of 'TSP selection'). This data is intended to assist industry in anticipation of these shipments being awarded on 27 March, 2015, when 2015 TDLs are anticipated for release.
4. We will continue to monitor and share data on pending shipments in the second to last step (status of 'Reviewed by Counselor and Approved to go to Route/Book') and the final step (status "TSP selection").
5. Current data shows that the granular blackouts use is being entered but we continue to encourage their use where applicable. For shipment awards after 27 March 2015, blackouts are at the following levels for the domestic market, sorted by largest volume of blackouts.

Blackouts by Zip3:	496 SCACs (9% increase in # blackouts since 13 May)
Blackouts by Channel:	532 SCACs (14% increase in # blackouts since 13 May)
Blackouts by Market/Channel:	247 SCACs (no change since 13 May)
Blackouts by Market/Zip3:	199 SCACs (19% increase in # blackouts since 13 May)
Blackouts by Cos/Channel:	151 SCACs (2% increase in # blackouts since 13 May)
Blackouts by Channel/COS/Zip3:	18 SCACs (no change since 13 May)
Blackouts by Cos/Zip3:	79 SCACs (4% increase in # blackouts since 13 May)
Blackouts by GBLOC/Channel:	44 SCACs (no change since 13 May)
