SUBJECT: Defense Personal Property Program (DP3) Peak Season Shipment Data & Blackouts Update #3

1. In preparation for the upcoming 2015 Peak Season, SDDC continues to monitor daily the Shipment Management queues for shipments picking up 15May 2015 and later as well as TSP blackouts. We encourage TSPs to use this data to manage their blackouts or plan to allocate resources since shipment refusals will not be allowed.

2. Data analysis as of 24 March shows there are 6,357 shipments awaiting creation of traffic distribution lists for 15May2015 and beyond. Of those, 4,671 are in the final step (status of 'Transportation Service Provider (TSP) Selection') awaiting the new Traffic Distribution List (TDL).

3. The attached report provides industry with details on the origin, destination, requested pickup date, and estimated weight of all 6,357 shipments (Code of service only available if in the final step of 'TSP selection'). This data is intended to assist industry in anticipation of these shipments being awarded on 27 March, 2015, when 2015 TDLs are anticipated for release.

4. We will continue to monitor and share data on pending shipments leading up to the creation of the TDL planned for 27 March 2015.

5. Current data shows that the granular blackouts use is being entered but we continue to encourage their use where applicable. For shipment awards 27 March 2015 and later, blackouts are at the following levels for, sorted by largest volume of blackouts.

*Blackouts by Market/Channel/Zip3:	49 SCACs (14,553 % increase in # since 23 March)
**Blackout by Market:	Decreased by 6% since 23 March
