SUBJ: DEFENSE PERSONAL PROPERTY SYSTEM (DPS) 2015 INTERNATIONAL VOLUME MOVE SOLICITATION NOTIFICATION

1. The DOD will be soliciting 12 ea. DPS International (INTL) Volume Moves (iVMs) on the following INTL channels for Code of Service (COS) 4 & J.

a. 6 ea. COS 4:

- 1) Pyongtak, Korea (KS - QXAK) -to- Fort Hood, TX (US66 - HBAT)
- 2) Pyongtak, Korea (KS - QXAK) -to- Fort Bliss, TX (US66 - HAAE)
- 3) Pyongtak, Korea (KS - QXAK) -to- Fort Benning, GA (US45 - CFAT)
- 4) Pyongtak, Korea (KS - QXAK) -to- Fort Bragg, NC (US40 - BKAS)
- 5) Pyongtak, Korea (KS - QXAK) -to- Fort Riley, KS (US58 - KOAT)
- 6) Pyongtak, Korea (KS - QXAK) -to- Fort Lewis, WA (US84 - JEAT)

NOTE 1: All COS 4 awarded under this iVM solicitation will have been already "Packed" and consolidated at a DPM local agent(s) warehouse. Bidding TSPs are required to decrease their current SFR by a minimum of \$5.00 cwt for the Non-Performance of Packing. The TSP's current Channel-COS rate on file SFR, decreased by \$5 cwt, will serve as the baseline SFR for TSPs. TSPs must submit a rate that is at least \$5 cwt lower than their rate on file for the same channel-COS. Bids that are not IAW this solicitation and the IT-15 Ch 9 will be subject to rejection of their iVM bid.

- 6) Pyongtak, Korea (KS - QXAK) -to- Fort Lewis, WA (US84 - JEAT)

NOTE 2: All COS J awarded under this iVM solicitation will have been already "Packed" and consolidated at a DPM local agent(s) warehouse. Bidding TSPs are required to decrease their current SFR by a minimum of \$5.00 cwt for the Non-Performance of Packing. The TSP's current Channel-COS rate on file SFR, decreased by \$5 cwt, will serve as the baseline SFR for TSPs. TSPs must submit a rate that is at least \$5 cwt lower than their rate on file for the same channel-COS. Bids that are not IAW this solicitation and the IT-15 Ch 9 will be subject to rejection of their iVM bid.
