SUBJECT: Defense Personal Property Program (DP3) Peak Season Update (Shipment Data & Blackouts Update #6)

1. In preparation for the upcoming 2015 Peak Season, SDDC continues to monitor daily the Shipment Management queues for shipments picking up 15 May 2015 and later as well as TSP blackouts. We encourage TSPs to use this data to manage their blackouts or plan to allocate resources since shipment refusals will not be allowed. This is expected to be the final daily data and blackout update message prior to the new peak season TDL being posted.
2. Data analysis as of 27 March shows there are 7,886 shipments awaiting creation of traffic distribution lists for 15 May 2015 and beyond. Of those, 6,610 are in the final step (status of 'Transportation Service Provider (TSP) Selection') awaiting the new Traffic Distribution List (TDL). The TDL is currently NOT available and we are working on a technical issue in efforts to turn it on as soon as possible. An update will follow this message later today.
3. The attached report provides industry with details on the origin, destination, requested pickup date, and estimated weight of all 7,886 shipments (Code of service only available if in the final step of 'TSP selection'). This data is intended to assist industry in anticipation of these shipments being awarded on 27 March, 2015, when 2015 TDLs are anticipated for release.
4. We will continue to monitor and share data on pending shipments leading up to the creation of the TDL planned for 27 March 2015.
5. Current data shows that the granular blackouts use is being entered but we continue to encourage their use where applicable. For shipment awards 27 March 2015 and later, blackouts are at the following levels.

Domestic

Blackouts by Channel/Zip3:	260 SCACs (2% increase in # since 26 March)
Blackouts by Channel:	602 SCACs (9% increase in # since 26 March)
Blackouts by Market/Channel:	296 SCACs (28% increase in # since 26 March)
Blackouts by Zip3:	577 SCACs (9% increase in # since 26 March)
Blackouts by Cos/Channel:	273 SCACs (92 % increase in # since 26 March)
Blackouts by Market/Zip3:	211 SCACs (4 % increase in # since 26 March)

Blackouts by Channel/COS/Zip3: 19 SCACs (2 % increase in # since 26 March)  
\*Blackouts by Market/Channel/Zip3: 56 SCACs (40% increase in # since 26 March)  
\*\*Blackout by Market: 201 SCACS (27% increase in # since 26 March)

GBLOC/Channel (Conus-Oconus): 24 SCACs (47% Increase in Blackouts)  
Market/channel/zip3 (Conus-Oconus): 7 SCACS (392% Increase in Blackouts)  
Channel/COS/ZIP 3 (Conus-Oconus): 377 SCACs (1000% Increase in Blackouts)  
COS (iHHG) 16 SCACs (200% Increase in Blackouts)  
Blackouts by Market/Zip3 (Ihhg) 38 SCACs (26% Increase in Blackouts)
