SUBJ: UPDATED CONUS TO/FROM CENTRAL & SOUTH AMERICA (INCLUDING MEXICO) DEFENSE PERSONAL PROPERTY PROGRAM (DP3) SPECIAL SOLICITATION (SS) AND ONE-TIME-ONLY (OTO) AREA OF RESPONSIBILITY GBLOC TRANSITION TO DEFENSE PERSONAL PROPERTY SYSTEM (DPS)

1. Effective 15 May 2015, the Department of Defense (DOD) will transition CONUS to/from Central & South America (including Mexico) SS and OTO shipment channels from Electronic Transportation Operations Personal Property System (ETOPS) to DPS SS and OTO shipment processes.

- a. On 15 May 2015 begin to route and award all SS and OTO CONUS to/from Central & South America (including Mexico) shipments in DPS.
- b. Prior to 15 May continue to process SS and OTO CONUS to/from Central & South America (including Mexico) in ETOPS using IS-15 SS rates on file or OTO solicitation processes.
- c. Current SS and OTO CONUS to/from Central & South America (including Mexico) shipments solicited, routed and awarded in ETOPS will not be impacted.

NOTE: Transition is in accordance with our 2015 Rate Filing Message dated 18 Dec 2014 and follow on SDDC-PP Advisory 15-0042 on Central & South America SS & OTO transition dated 11 March 2015.

2. UPDATED: JPPSO-South Central will assume inbound responsibility and outbound booking responsibility for shipments out of Central/South America (including Mexico). All shipments being picked up within a PPSO/JPPSO AOR for movement to these locations will be processed in DPS by the responsible PPSO/JPPSO. The PPPO office at Ellington FLD ANGB, Houston, TX will provide DPS Counseling services for members moving out of Central/South America (including Mexico). Further details will be provided in the Personal Property Consignment Instruction Guide (PPCIG) and Move.mil.

3. DP3 Stakeholders should review the DPS PPCIG in advance of the transition date for Central and South America (including Mexico) for updated guidelines, requirements, and country instructions particular to the affected inbound and outbound countries/rate areas.
