Subject: Update To the Defense Personal Property System (DPS) 2015 International Volume Moves (iVMs)

1. Be advised, starting 15 June thru 30 September, the PPSOs listed below will start to see an increase in iHHGs (COS 4) and iUB (COS J) shipments in their "inbound" queues coming from Korea (QXAK). SDDC-PP anticipates the volume may range from 50 to 600 shipments for the specified date range.

- a. Fort Hood, TX (US66 - HBAT)
- b. Fort Bliss, TX (US66 - HAAE)
- c. Fort Benning, GA (US45 - CFAT)
- d. Fort Bragg, NC (US40 - BKAS)
- e. Fort Riley, KS (US58 - KOAT)
- f. Fort Lewis, WA (US84 - JEAT)
- g. Fort Carson, CO (US74 - KKFA)
- h. Fort Campbell, KY (US28 - FAAT)
- i. Fort Stewart, GA (US45 - CHAT)
- j. Fort Polk, LA (US64 - FSAT)
- k. Fort Drum, NY (US17 - DBAT)

2. As a reminder, PPSOs should monitor and manage their queues daily. Although the volume may vary from day to day, the destination GBLOCs should be prepared to handle the increased workload.
