Subject: Reducing the Expanded Defense Personal Property Program (DP3) Short Fuse Window for the 2015 Peak Season

1. Effective 6 July 2015, SDDC will reduce the short fuse days from 10 government business days (GBDs) back to the normal 5 GBDs, one day at a time, so that on 10 July the normal 5 GBDs short fuse window will be in effect. For example, on 6 July a shipment will be classified as short fuse if it is picking up 10 GBDs out (17 July or earlier), 7 July will be 9 GBDs (17 July or earlier), 8 July 8 GBDs (17 July or earlier), 9 July 7 GBDs and etc.
2. SDDC will continue monitoring blackouts and conduct an analysis on this adjustment after peak season to determine effectiveness and whether to continue using short fuse expansion in the program. Please ensure widest dissemination within your organizations, so all key personnel are aware of the updated adjustment.
