Subject: Turkey, Authorized Departure and Potential Stop Movement

1. The Department of Defense has issued an authorized departure message (attached), effective 2 Sept 2015, of eligible family members from the Adana, Turkey area, to include Incirlik Air Base with designated Safe Haven in the United States
2. This message advises Personal Property Shipping Offices to be prepared for possible stop movement and diversion instructions to be issued for shipments destined for Turkey.
3. Use the Defense Personal Property System to monitor shipments leaving your AOR in preparation for further guidance.

SUBJECT: Authorized Departure – Adana, Turkey

The Department of State (DoS) approved an authorized departure, effective September 2, 2015, of DoS eligible family members (EFM) from Adana, Turkey, and designated Ankara, Turkey as the safe haven for DoS EFMs. The Department of Defense (DoD) has authorized the departure of DoD EFMs from the Adana, Turkey, area to include Incirlik Air Base. For DoD EFMs, the safe haven has been designated as the United States. Alternate safe havens may be approved on a case-by-case basis.

Stop Movement: U.S. Government-funded travel to the Adana, Turkey, area for all DoD dependents is suspended. The authorized departure and stop movement will remain in effect for a period not to exceed 30 days.

EFMs of DoD military personnel will be processed for safe haven allowances in accordance with Joint Travel Regulations (JTR), Chapter 6, Part A1. EFMs of DoD civilian employees will be processed for allowances in accordance with JTR, Chapter 6, Part B.
