Subject: Update 1 REAL ID Act Implementation

1. Reference SDDC-PP ADVISORY 15-0131 dated 10 Sept 15. This update informs shippers and Transportation Service Providers (TSPs) of the REAL ID Act of 2005 implementation in the Federal government and the potential impact to DOD installation access.
2. All Federal agencies are prohibited from accepting driver's licenses or state identification cards from States deemed non-REAL ID Act compliant for physical access to Federal facilities (including DoD installations and facilities). The Department of Homeland Security (DHS) (Federal lead for ensuring REAL ID Act compliance) has published guidance, which DOD and other Federal agencies have or will begin to enforce. 3. **UPDATE:** In addition to Minnesota and American Samoa, there are 4 states that have not yet received an extension for 2016 and were deemed non-compliant on 10 January, 2016. Those states are Illinois, Missouri, New Mexico, and Washington. TSPs with a driver's license from the above listed states and territory will need an alternate ID in order to access Federal facilities, to include DOD installations.
4. The Real ID implementation document published by the Interagency Security Committee, provides a list of alternative forms of Federal identification that may be accepted for DOD installation access in lieu of a REAL ID Act compliant driver's license. Examples of alternate forms of identification that may be accepted include: Enhanced Driver's License, Transportation Worker Identification Credential (TWIC), US Passport, US Passport Card, US Military ID, DHS "Trusted Traveler" Cards, and others. NOTE: The TWIC is already specifically authorized in DOD policy as an identification card to facilitate physical access to DOD installations.
