To: All Military Service Headquarters Representatives, Worldwide Personal Property Shipping Offices (PPSO), and Transportation Service Providers (TSP)

Subject: Volume Move (VM) from Ft Hood, TX to Ft Sill, OK is available for bidding in the Defense Property System (DPS)

1. A VM has been submitted through DPS (number VM-16-0002) from Fort Hood, Texas to Fort Sill, Oklahoma with a bid end date of 22 March 2016 at 1300 Central Daylight Time (CDT). The start date of the VM is 1 April 2016 and the end date is 15 July 2016. VMs are not restricted by the Rate Cycle Dates, or Performance Periods and the accepted rate will apply until the VM shipment is delivered to the customer.
2. SDDC encourages all TSPs with approved rates on file for this market/channel/COS to place competitive bids during the solicitation periods IAW Rate Filing User Guide-TSP Edition available in the TSP DPS Training tab. TSPs with valid rates on file and who aren't in a punitive status are eligible to bid and received an e-mail from DPS (User roles TSP Master, TSP Operation and TSP Rate Filing Rep) identifying the VM solicitation.
3. Transportation offices are encouraged to review movement requirements into or out of their AOR and consider submitting a VM request in DPS for peak season if they have sufficient tonnage. PPSOs can submit a VM request in DPS for movement of household goods from one origin city (within 75 miles) to one destination city (within 75 miles) within a 90-day period and totaling 200,000 pounds or more, or unaccompanied baggage totaling 50,000 pounds or more.
