Subject: JPPSO-Japan Regionalization

1. Effective today, 1 April 2016, the Camp S.D. Butler, Okinawa PPSO (QIMS) was regionalized under JPPSO-Japan (QENQ). Origin J/C/PPSOs are reminded to consign shipments for all USMC personnel, Navy Personnel assigned to Marine Corps units, personnel assigned to the Navy Hospital on Camp Lester Okinawa, and Department of Defense Education Activity (DoDEA) personnel assigned on Marine Corps Installations on Okinawa to JPPSO-Japan (QENQ).
2. For Code J UB, Code T HHG, and DPM shipments: J/C/PPSOs are reminded the correct Aerial Port of Debarkation (APOD) for shipments to Camp Butler, Okinawa is DNA (Kadena AB). Please ensure APOD code DNA is selected in the DPS drop-down menu to preclude shipment misroute, inconvenience to customers, and additional transportation expenses.
3. JPPSO-Japan Regionalization: All shipments previously consigned to Camp Zama (QFAC), Sasebo Japan (QENF) Atsugi Japan (QENL) and Yokosuka itself will be consigned to JPPSO-Japan (QENQ) with APOD of Yokota (OKO). MCAS Iwakuni Japan (QEML) consigned to JPPSO-Japan (QENQ) with APOD of Iwakuni (IWA). Camp S.D. Butler (QIMS) on Okinawa now under QENQ is to be routed to APOD of Kadena (DNA).
4. Other Japan destined shipments: Yokota AB (QFFL), Misawa AB (QEFL), and Kadena AB (QIFL) remain consigned to their own GBLOCs and should be routed as the PPCIG instructs.
