Subject: Update to SDDC-PP Advisory 16-0019 Notification of SDDC Secretary of State Review

1. IAW SDDC Pamphlet 55-4 paragraph 3.0.5 "The TSP must maintain valid household goods operating authority and mandatory levels of insurance at all times. Approved TSPs have a continuing obligation during any period of performance to immediately disclose any change in circumstances concerning the necessary requirements under federal and state law to conduct household goods transportation. In the event that the lawful authority of a TSP is revoked, or a change in circumstances would result in the operating authority being deemed invalid, the TSP has a legal obligation to immediately contact SDDC concerning these developments." Paragraph 3.10 " Federal and State Regulatory Compliance- TSPs are required to comply at all times with all applicable Federal, State and Local requirements for the movement and storage of personal property.

2. The Surface Deployment and Distribution Command's (SDDC) Personal Property Directorate is conducting a review of all TSP's compliance with state requirements as defined by each Secretary of State and has found several TSP's who are not in compliance with this requirement.

3. TSP's must be in compliance with state requirements no later than May 1, 2016. Failure to comply will result in a minimum 30 day non-use.
